



The Ford Family Foundation Scholarship Program for Sons and Daughters of Employees of Roseburg Forest Products Co. *Oregon*

Kenneth W. Ford and The Ford Family Foundation established the Ford Sons & Daughters Program to provide scholarships to sons and daughters of Roseburg Forest Products Co. employees as they pursue education beyond high school. Each year, up to 10% of all eligible applicants are selected to receive the Ford Sons & Daughters scholarship.

Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a dependent child or stepchild of an employee of Roseburg Forest Products Co. The employee must be full time and have been employed by Roseburg Forest Products, Co. for a minimum of 18 months as of March 1 of the application year
- Be 21 years of age or younger to enter the scholarship program. If selected, recipients may continue in the program beyond age 21
- Attend full time, on campus, beginning in fall of the application year
- Not have previously earned a bachelor's degree
- Plan to pursue a 2-year, 4-year or technical degree

Financial need is considered, but is not a required element.

Applicants are encouraged to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as they may be eligible for other forms of financial aid.

Selection Criteria

Each successful candidate will demonstrate:

- Good character
- Evidence of volunteer service activities in their school and community
- Strong work ethic
- Academic success and appropriate academic preparation for career goal
- An ability to clearly communicate personal strengths and goals
- A sound educational plan

All eligible applicants are interviewed.

Eligible Institutions

Eligible institutions include any 2-year or 4-year, public or private, non-profit or for-profit, post-secondary institution in the United States that is eligible to participate in federal Title IV student financial aid programs.

Scholarship Amount

Scholarship award amounts for the Ford Sons & Daughters Program depend on the type of college the recipient is attending. A recipient attending a 2-year college will receive an award amount of \$3,000 each academic year. A recipient attending a 4-year college will received an award amount of \$5,000 each academic year. This scholarship can be renewed annually if the student makes satisfactory academic progress.

To Apply

Apply online through the Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC) at www.GetCollegeFunds.org/eApp.html. The 2010-11 Oregon Scholarship eApp Workbook is available after October 15, through most Oregon high schools and colleges. **Deadline:** All application materials must be submitted online by March 1 of each year.
